

FoNAC is in our 8th year of formal ministry. The first few years were devoted to introduction and securing funding for basic operations. Next we entered into a partnership with the North American Mission Board, of the SBC in which FoNAC was to serve as a clearinghouse (an agency or organization which collects and distributes something, especially information), which has worked well for all concerned. We have made a good number of contacts and throughout our short tenure have dispersed much information through printed publications, video & telephone conferencing, Baptist Press Releases, Regional conferences.
